88% of our first-year students returned this fall, which is almost 20 points higher than the national average. We'll challenge you academically because we know you'll have the resources to succeed:

- **Health Professions Advising:** advisors to help you create your target program list, write essays, and prepare for interviews, and to write letters of recommendation for you. (They will even work with you after graduation!)
- **Career & Employment Services:** to connect you with internships and on- and off-campus jobs, and support you in writing a resume and preparing for interviews.
- **Center for Writing & Learning:** tutoring by subject and writing support, including for ELL.
- **Peer Advising:** juniors and seniors who act as advocates and allies for first-year students.
- **Faculty Advising:** faculty advisors to support academic decision-making, plan for careers, and/or prepare for graduate school.

AT PUGET SOUND, YOUR WELL-BEING COMES FIRST.

To have the freedom to grow, you'll need holistic support.

- **Student Success Coaches:** for every first-year student! To troubleshoot things like organization, accessing campus resources, or finding opportunities to build community.
- **Counseling, Health & Wellness:** on-site physicians, nurses, and counselors who can also provide personalized referrals to local clinics.
- **Student Diversity & Social Justice Centers:** communal gathering spaces for all who hope to work toward a more equitable campus, city, and world, holding space in particular for those historically underrepresented in higher education.
- **Center for Student Support:** a home for services such as peer advising, a lending library, and a food pantry, to ensure all students can get what they need, when they need it.
- **LGBTQ-Inclusive:** policies, programs, and practices awarded four stars by Campus Pride Index.
- **Security Services:** available 24/7 to ensure you feel safe in your new home.

Puget Sound is truly residential — more than 70% of students live on campus! Many students choose to stay for all four years of study to benefit from the close-knit community.

- **Residence Halls:** where most first- and second-year students live. Each hall includes a common area and a kitchen, and is accessible for nonbinary students and students of all abilities.
- **Themed Living:** unique opportunities to live with those who share your academic interests, hobbies, or identity!
- **Suites:** Generally reserved for upperclass students, suites feature single rooms with shared bathroom, kitchen, and living room.
- **Greek Life:** 8 chapter houses for the 33% of students who belong to a sorority or fraternity.
- **Campus Houses:** Create your own community in one of 47 university-owned houses.
